STRUCTURE

Imagine 2.0 is divided into fifteen units. Odd-numbered units are content-based, and even-numbered units are literature-based.

Each unit contains three sections.

- The *Read and Think* section exposes students to new language through content-based texts and develops literary skills related to the *Reader* texts.
- The Look and Learn section presents new language and provides controlled and freer practice.
- The Speak and Write section guides students to oral and written production of new language.

Each section offers a variety of activities that take the students from exposure, through presentation and practice, to production. The *Activity Book* provides practice and consolidation for the *Student's Book* and offers the following additional sections:

- The About Me pages allow students to reflect on and personalize the theme of the unit.
- The Cross-Curricular pages give students the chance to apply their new skills and knowledge to other subjects.
- The Writing Strategies pages allow students to express themselves more creatively and accurately in print.
- The Literary Response pages enable students to express their appreciation and understanding of literature.
